State of Indiana, Montgomery county, ss. PROBATE COURT, May term, 1836. David Long, administrator of the estate of Isaac Anderson, dec'd, vs. The creditors of said estate.—Petition for settlement of said estate as insolvent. The petitioner having filed his petition, shewing therein among other things, that the personal projeriy of said estate (there being no real) is insufficient to pay the debts and demands outstanding against the same, it is therefore ordered that notice of the pendency of said petition be given by publication in the Crawfordsville Record, six weeks in succession , that unless said creditors notify said administrator of the existence and extent of their respective claims by filing the same, or a statement of the nature, description and date of the contract, or assumes it upon which the same may be founded, in the office of the clerk of this court, previous to the final distribution of the assets of said estate, such claims will be postponed in favor of the more diligent creditors; and cause continued.
