Monday the will of AP Luse was read at Chicago but it was not admitted to probate and will not be for a week or two. John Marder, Mr. Luse's partner and AB Anderson of Crawfordsville were named as executors and also as trustees. The fortune will amount to over \$300,000 and much of it is in property that Messrs. Marder and Anderson will have charge of for several years.

JW Allen, a half brother, living at Indianapolis gets \$5,000 and each of his four children, \$1,000.

JP Luse of Rapids City, Dakota, brother, \$10,000 and each of his two daughters, \$10,000.

Cyrus P. Luse, Minneapolis, brother \$10,000 and \$10,000 to each of his three daughters and one son.

FT Luse, Crawfordsville, brother \$20,000.

Mrs. AB Bosserman, Lafayette, sister, \$1000 one-half of the income from 1,350 acres of land near Chicago and one half the interest on \$60,000 during her life.

Miss WW Huston, Chicago, cousin, the same as Mrs. Bosserman.

Miss Athela Luse, adopted daughter, \$10,000 which was the amount of Mr. Luse's life insurance, the furniture in the Chicago residence and the interest of \$5,000 during her life.

On the death of Mrs. Bosserman and Miss Huston the \$60,000 above mentioned will revert to FT and JP Luse and their heirs and on the death of Miss Luse the \$50,000 will be divided among FT, JP and CP Luse and their heirs.
