

US Army Reserve, Waveland

Approval was given last week by the House Appropriations Committee to a bill which calls for the construction of 11 Army reserve training buildings, one of which will be built at Waveland. The Waveland building will be designed for 100 men and is expected to cost \$79,000. It became apparent a few weeks ago that such a structure would be erected here and Army officials visited Waveland to look over a number of suggested sites. The Waveland Reserve unit is one of the finest and has been highly recommended. IN its report the House Committee recommended that Congress approve exactly what the Army asked in order to improve standby reserve training. Col. William R. Shuler, Army construction division chief, told the committee the training facilities are mandatory "if we are going to give a realistic training program."
