Garry Bazzani, starting guard on the Waveland basketball team will miss the sectional tournament because of an injury he received in a game late in the season. Bazzani, a 5-9 senior who had started in nearly all of the Hornets' games and had scored 98 points, sustained a shoulder separation during the Waveland-Waynetown contest Feb. 8. The youngster was admitted to Culver Hospital for treatment of the injury. A versatile athlete, Bazzani was a member of the 1963 Hornet team which finished runner-up in the sectional. He had his best game this year on Nov. 15 when he tallied 14 points against Coal Creek. - typed by his sister, Karen Bazzani Zach

Garry was struck by a throw in the 3rd inning and was taken to Culver in Crawfordsville where he underwent minor surgery for a broken cartilage. Several x-rays were also taken of his nose which is badly swollen. His mother reported him in severe pain Wednesday morning.
