

## ALICE BROWN - serious car accident

**Miss Alice BROWN was seriously injured in an automobile accident during the holidays. She with three other young people, Don LEWIS, Joe PRATT and Louise WOODS were enroute to Cincinnati about 1:30 a.m. on the morning of July 5th when about 20 miles out of Batesville, the driver, Don Lewis, lost control of the car as he turned around to say something to those in the back seat and the car left the road and went over an embankment and turned over. Joe Pratt was killed instantly. The other three were taken to a Batesville Hospital in an ambulance where it was found that Alice had suffered two broken arms. Her left arm was broken above the elbow and right one in two places below the elbow. Several stitches were taken in this arm and a temporary cast placed on it. She also received several cuts and bruises and a wound over one eye, requiring a stitch or two. The other girl received a back injury and will have to stay in a cast for some time. The Lewis boy, whose neck was injured was taken to Camp Atterbury Sunday evening where he was in the service. Mr. and Mrs. Everett McCLOUD brought Alice home Sunday evening. On Saturday she will have a permanent cast placed on her right arm.**
