

Jesse DANIEL & Marquis BURRIS Die in Collision

A two-car collision 3 miles east of Rockville on US 36 Friday night, Dec 20, 1963 claimed the lives of Jesse DANIEL, 73, of Rockville and Marquis BURRIS, 53, of Wapella, Ill and injured 3 others. Mrs. Bessie Burris, 54 wife of Marquis was in serious condition at Union Hospital in Terre Haute. Less seriously injured were: Francis Willis, 30 and William Leach. Funeral services for Jesse Daniels were held at 2 p.m. Monday at Barnes Mortuary at Rockville. Burial in Memory Garden. Mrs. Daniels had been a barber in Clinton 32 years before going to Rockville 20. Surviving include the widow, Emma; two daughter, Mrs. Evelyn Champion and Mrs. Ruth Christian; two brothers, a sister, two grandchildren and 5 greats.
