Source: Weekly Argus News, April 10, 1897 p 4 Insanity proceedings were this Wednesday held over the person of Lizzie B. Jolly of Wingate, Dr. Keegan assisted by justices of the Peace, Stephen A. Stilwell and Wm. T. Hanna held the inquest. Mrs. Jolly was found to be of unsound mind and in a condition dangerous to the community. Papers were made out in the afternoon and she was taken to the asylum for the insane at Indianapolis. Mrs. Jolly's condition is attributed to a fall sustained while a child, which affected her spinal cord and which now has caused insanity.
