He, with two other boys, Charles Swadley and Rollo Beckley had gone swimming, taking with them a .22 rifle. In sport Swadley pointed the rifle at the Lamson boy, when it was discharged, the bullet passing within an inch of his heart. The boys were about the same age and great friends. Mr. Lamson is a brother of the Lamson boys resided here, and is commonly known as "Dude." He has had more than his share of bad luck.
