MITCHELL SHOT

We learned this morning, that a young man by the name of Mitchell, residing about half a miles south west of this city, when on his way near home, at about 8 o'clock last night, was seriously wounded by a pistol shot. The ball entered at the point of the nose, passing up and through the left eye, finding lodgement somewhere probably in the front of the head. On examination, its exact locality could not be ascertained. The perpetrator of this murderous act is, as yet, unknown. - thanks Kim H
