The unloaded gun got in its deadly work at Yountsville, Tuesday. Glenn Rallston of Crawfordsville, 17 years old, was boat riding with a couple of companions and in a bantering spirit one of them threatened to shoot Ralston (sic), pointed the gun at him and pulled the trigger. The weapon, a 22 calibre rifle, proved to be loaded, and the ball took effect in Ralston's bowels. He died on Wednesday. Rev. LF Galey preached the funeral at Crawfordsville yesterday.
