Mr. Wilson brought her down town on a shopping errand and when she returned home shortly after 2 o'clock she found a number of friends gathere there to help her celebrate the event. It was a complete surprise and as she walked into her home and right among the ladies there assembled, she exclaimed, "What does this all mean? and looked to Mr. Wilson as if to ask him why he had not told her about the company coming. It was a happy event for both Mrs. Wilson and her guests and every one there were happy to have been an invited guest. Refreshments of brick ice cream, pink and white cake and nabiscos were served. The company numbered 15, including Mrs. Wilson and the combined ages totaled 1104 years.
