The jury in the petition to have Mrs. Nancy Abbott of Ladoga declared a person of unsound mind returned the verdict late on Saturday afternoon and its decision was favorable to the plaintiff. Mrs. Eliza Moore who is one of a large number of Mrs. Abbott's heirs at law. By the jury's verdict a guardian will now have to be appointed by the court and when that is done, Mr. John Talbot, who for a number of years has been Mrs. Abbott's financial agent, will be asked to give an accounting of the money which has passed through his hands. It is claimed the attorneys for the petitioner in the case just closed that Mr. Talbott will have some trouble in telling what went with all of the money it being stated that he will be found to be about \$4,000 short with no means to make the shortage good. Whether this be true or not will doubtless come out in another action which will be filed later, after the guardian is appointed. - kbz
