The fire started on the roof and had gained such headway that nothing could be done. All the stuff on the ground floor was gotten out, the contents of the second floor, including most of their clothing and bedding were burned. The loss is partially covered by insurance. For the present the Campbells are living in the Bloomfield tenant house on East Howard Street. The house was built about seventeen years ago by Frank McClain, who later sold the place to A.C. Deere, who in turn sold to Mr. Campbell. Much sympathy is expressed for Mr. and Mrs. Campbell in their loss.
