Gerald Campbell, a farmer living east of Crawfordsville and north of Smartsburg has been pronounced by physicians to be suffering from infantile paralysis. He is quarantined at his home for the present. He is the second case of polio in the county. Mrs. Ruby Cox of Darlington the first case has so far recovered after treatment at Riley hospital to be removed to the home of her sister, Mrs. Clarence Surface near New Market.
