Mrs. Florence Canine who appeared before the members of the city council Monday night denies she was there primarily to protest against imposition of rent controls in the city but rather to complain against increased city tax rates. Mrs. Canine who said she was spokesman for six widows who attended the Council meeting said she told the council they were there to find out how much the new hangars at the municipal airport were going to cost the tax payers. City officials stated Wednesday the cost of the hangers will be paid with an appropriation made from city light plat funds and not with tax dollars. There is a one-cent rate next year however for maintenance of the airport SW of the city. Mrs. Canine said during her talk she did complain that she and other property owners whose income is from rentals were handicapped by the increased taxes while at the same time their rental rates were frozen.
