

CRAWFORDSVILLE SANITORIUM

Crawfordsville is to have a sanitorium where diseases of all descriptions may be treated. Dr. Henry V. Wall, a graduate of the Hahnemann Medical College of the Kansas City University and Dr. HJ Helfrich of Louisville will be the proprietors. For the present their quarters will be at the Robbins House where they have engaged 15 rooms. It is their purpose to obtain a large residence in the outskirts of the city which is very desirable for their purpose. They will then make all necessary improvements and be prepared to accommodate a large number of patients. Their apparatus has not all arrived yet, but in a short time they will be in a shape to treat all who come. They anticipate a large practice in view of the fact that this is such a city as will be pleasant for invalids to stop in for treatment. - kbz
