A barn belonging to Chas. Enoch burned early on Sunday morning. When the fire was discovered the roof was falling in and the building and contents were a total loss. The barn was nearly new. It contained a quantity of hay, 300 bushels of oats, 125 bushels of corn, 50 bushels of rye, a wagon, new buggy and farming implements. Another wagon, standing by the side of the barn was saved. Mr. Enoch had \$250 insurance on the barn and the same amount on the hay and grain and a small amount on his farming implements. It is a heavy loss to him. The fire was under such headway that there was no clue to the cause. - typed by kbz
