

(Ben) GOODEN LAW SUIT settled

The suit filed by Mrs. Ben Gooden in circuit court holding the Edgerton Manufacturing Company responsible for the death of her husband last June 2, was tried in circuit court this morning. Judge Artman of Indianapolis tried the case and holds the company liable under the workmen's compensation law. Mrs. Gooden is to receive a compensation for 500 weeks but the amount each week is not determined. Mr. Gooden met his death last June when he was unloading some logs for the Edgerton timber company on the Vandalia RR when he was run over by a car. -- kbz
