

HAYTEN FLOUR MILL

The flouring mill of Thomas Hayten at New Ross was totally destroyed by fire at 10 o'clock Wednesday mornong. Over 5,000 bushels of what in storage in the mill belonging to farmers of the vicinity was also consumed. The fire originated from a defective flue and when discovered was under such headway that all efforts to save the structure were fruitless. The mill and the grain will be a total loss as neither Mr. Hayten or the owners of the wheat carried a cent of insurance. - transcribed by kbz
