White church is situated six miles northeast of Darlington, was not a new structure but was well kept and good as new and cost \$1200. Friday night was the regular night for foot washing and sou-meeting and as there has been a good deal of rioting and trouble at those meetings heretofore it is supposed the church was maliciously fired to prevent the church people from having their regular service. This church is only about a mile from where George W. Boots' barn was lately burned it is suggested the same chap may have had a hand in both. The matter should be thoroughly investigated - kbz
