TAKEN UP ... by Robert Warren living about one and a half miles SE from Crawfordsville, Montgomery Co Indiana – 3 estray Oxen the one a pale red steer, white on his tail and white on his belly and white on the top of his rump, is marked with a crop and underbit in the left and under half crop in the right ear and has on a Bell with a leather collar and common buckle – appraised to \$16.25. The other a Black Steer marked the same as the red one – appraised to \$15. The other a dark brindle steer with broad horns and marked with a swallow fork in each ear, has on a bell with a leather collar and common buckle – with the bell appraised to \$16.25. These steers appear to be about 7 or 8 years old and appear to be work oxen. D. Johnson and James Anderson appraisers ... PM Currey, JP Crawfordsville Jan 21, 1834 - #51
