The marshal was called in and took Wrightsman to Crawfordsville where he is now in cold storage. Mrs. Wrightsman was ready to stand up for her spouse in spite of his love taps, and declared that he could only be removed over her dead body. They have been having more or less trouble for some time and the marshal was called in once before to restore peace. They have two children, one of them but a few weeks old. Mrs. Wrightsman has gone to Crawfordsville to stay with her sister.
