Traffic safety officials predicted 20 persons would die in Indiana during the 102-hour holiday period between 6 p.m. Wednesday and midnight Sunday. Last Thanksgiving 18 deaths were reported.

Patricia White, 34, Madison, died when two cars collided on rainslick Indiana 56 west of Hanover, police said. They said a car driven by Danice Colson, 31, Scottsburg, skidded head-on into the car driven by Mrs. White's husband.

Brigitte Whitehead, 44, Anderson, was killed late Saturday night when her car struck a tree along a Madison

County road.

- Kay Ferverda, 18, North Webster, was killed Saturday when her car collided with a Conrail freight train in Leesburg.
