His daughter Eureka was born in 1871 and his second daughter Mena was born in 1873 in Denmark. In 1876 his first son, Yorgan (George) was born in Indiana and Frederick was born in 1879. The 1880 census shows the Madsen's living in Lake Village, IN. In 1888 his son, Abbert was born in Lake Village. Martin became a naturalized citizen in 1890.

She was born on July 10, 1847 in Jerslev, Hjørring, Denmark, Death 1930 in Lake Village, IN. Martin and Patrine arrived in America around 1874. Children:

(1876-1961) was born in January 21, 1876 and married Ada Spair (1882-). On Sept. 23, 1898 his son, (Harry) Ernest was born, Dallas F. was in 1900, Bertha in 1902, Meddie in 1909 and Porter in 1913. George died September 10, 1961 and is buried in the Lake Village Cemetery. George's children were:

- Dallas F. (1900-1960) was born in Lake Village in 1900. He married Vinnie L. (Brown) (1907-1987) and he and Vinnie are buried in the Lake Village Cemetery.
- Bertha L. (1902-) married Carroll James (1905-1979) on June 11, 1930 and lived in Morocco. Both are buried in the Oakland Cemetery near Morocco.
- Meddie (1908-1979) married Madeline Parks(1910-??) on Sept. 12, 1928. Both are buried in the Lake Village Cemetery.
- Porter L. (1913–2007) was born in Lake Village on May 7, 1913 and died on Feb. 14, 2007 in Lake Village, IN. Porter married Edith Ann Cummings (1913-1981) on June 28, 1936. Porter and Edith are buried in the Lake Village Cemetery.

- Gilbert George 'Dutch' (1904–1990) was born on May 4, 1904 and died on May 21, 1990. He married Zella West (1912-1984) on Nov. 26, 1930. They are buried in the Lake Village Cemetery.
