Albert Britton, 71, former prominent Decatur resident, died suddenly Saturday at his home in Owosso, Mich. He was a native of Adams County, and was active in various enterprises having been one of the organizers of the Big Store for several years, the largest retail store in the city. He served one term as Decatur postmaster, beginning in 1902. He moved to Owosso 35 years ago.

Surviving are the widow, formerly Alma Madden; one daughter, Marian of Lake George, Mich.; two son, Ralph of Dallas, Tex., and Donald of Illinois; one brother, W. P. of Dallas; three half-sisters, Mrs. Charles Knapp of Decatur, Mrs. Nora Del Grumble of Passton, Pa., and Mrs. Rose Ralston of Savannah, Ga., and two half-brothers, Carl Smith of Dallas and Marion Smith of Owosso.
