

GUMP

George Gump, a pioneer resident of Allen county, died Saturday at the home of his son, Calvert Gump, two and a half miles east of Huntertown. Death was due to a stroke of paralysis which he sustained last Tuesday.

Mr. Gump was eighty-seven years of age, and had lived in Allen county since 1848. He was formerly a farmer, but of late years had retired from active life. In 1849 he was united in marriage to Miss Harriet Agenbroad, and to this union there were born thirteen children, five of whom with the mother have preceded Mr. Gump in death. Surviving children are Frank Gump, of Nebraska City, Neb., and Mrs. Alice Flanagan, Mrs. Priscilla Jackson, Mrs. Jane Hursh, Mrs. Cora Shambaugh, and Madison, Marion and Calvert Gump, all of Allen county.

Funeral services were held this afternoon.
