

C.M. Keller, 66, dies in Washington

C.M. (Cash) Keller, 66, former Huntington and Fort Wayne newspaperman, and husband of the former Miss Helen Hain of this city, died early Sunday at his home in Washington, D.C. He was a member of the news staff of the U.S. Information Agency in Washington.

A native of Huntington, Mr. Keller was at one time sports editor of the Huntington Herald-Press and later was basketball coach for several years at Huntington Catholic high school.

Mrs. Keller worked for a number of newspapers, including the Fort Wayne Journal-Gazette.

During World War II, he was a communications officer with the Pacific Fleet based at Sydney, Australia. After the war, he served on the news staff of radio station WRC in Washington.

Surviving in addition to his wife are two sons, John and David Keller; and a brother, Kenneth B. Keller of Fort Wayne.

Services will be held Tuesday morning in Washington, with interment in that city. The Gawlor funeral home is in charge of arrangements. (Nov. 1, 1971)
