MRS. ED KOCHER DIES THURSDAY

Former Emma Burry of This Community Dies at Stroh.

Mrs. Ed Kocher, aged 52, formerly Emma Burry of this community, died at 10:30 o'clock Thursday forenoon at her home at Stroh, Indiana. Death was caused by apoplexy. Mrs. Kocher had been ill since Sunday.

Mrs. Kocher was born in this community, September 26, 1885, a daughter of John and Anna Burry. She was married early in life to Ed Kocher, also a native of this community, and the couple lived east of Berne, where Herman Ryf now resides, for several years. They moved to Stroh a number of years ago, where Mr. Kocher is employed.

Surviving are the husband and nine children, Rufus, of Stroh; Roy Decatur; Alvin, Stroh; Lester, Dayton, Ohio; Weldon, Margaret, Mildrend, Chester and Genevieve, all at Stroh. The mother survives, Mrs. John Burry of Geneva. One brother and one sister survive, William Burry and Mrs. Ernest Huggel, both of near Geneva.

The father, three brothers and sisters and three children preceded.

The funeral will be held Sunday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home at Stroh and at 2 o'clock at the church, also at Stroh.
