

Cornelius McGough Is Taken By Death

Cornelius McGough, 91-year-old retired farmer died at 4 p.m. Thursday at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Harold Shoemaker, Geneva, with whom he resided. He had been in failing health for the past year.

He was born in Lafayette, Feb. 11, 1872, a son of Henry and Jane Dull-McGough, but had resided near Willshire, O., most of his life. He was married Dec. 18, 1907, to Mary Butler, who preceded him in death Aug. 21, 1958.
