

Bertha McMichael Dies Last Evening

Mrs. Bertha D. McMichael, 72, a resident of St. Mary's township, Decatur route 5, died at 6:30 p.m. Thursday at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been in failing health for some time and hospitalized to the past eight days.

Born in Van Wert county, O., Aug. 26, 1890, she was a daughter of James and Sarah Cratner--Mauler, and was married to Austin e. McMichael, March 18, 1915, in Van Wert. Her husband preceded her in death June 21, 1962.

Mr. McMichael was a member of Mt. Tabor Methodist church at Bobo, and the St. Mary's Home Demonstration club.

Surviving are two foster children, Harry Mc. Dermott of Decatur route 5, and Austin R. Krick of Piedmont, S.D., and one grandson, Harry Leo McDermott. Six brothers and sisters are deceased.
