

## SCHLATTER FUNERAL IS HELD TODAY MOTHER OF MRS. PALMER MOSER DIES AT COUNTY HOSPITAL

Mrs. Anna Schlatter, 93, who made her home with a daughter, Mrs. Palmer Moser of Berne, died at 3:45 p.m. Friday in the Adams County Memorial hospital in Decatur.

She was a native of Allen county, living most of her life near Leo. In recent years she made her home with her children.

Mrs. Schlatter was the oldest member of the Leo Mennonite church and the widow of Jonas Schlatter who died in 1953.

Survivors include four other daughters, Mrs. Henry Amstutz, Celina, Ohio, Mrs. S. J. Miller, Leo, Mrs. Menno Neuhauser, Napoleon, Ohio, and Mrs. Amos Aschliman, West Liberty, Ohio; a son, Harry Schlatter, Maumee, Ohio; 20 grandchildren; 49 great-grandchildren; and four great-great-grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Leah Smead, R. R. 1, Grabill.

Three step-grandchildren and six step-great-grandchildren also survive.
