

Mrs. Mary Stuckey Is Taken By Death

Mrs. Mary Stuckey, 91, mother of Victor L. Stuckey, manager of the Berne Equity Exchange, died Wednesday morning in the home of her daughter, Mrs. Hugh Weinman, near Chattanooga, O. The widow of Frederick Stuckey, Mrs. Stuckey had resided in Berne for a few years.

A native of Liberty township, Mercer county, Ohio, Mrs. Stuckey was born August 10, 1871, the daughter of Jacob and Caroline Baker. She was married to Frederick Stuckey July 11, 1894 and he preceded her in death in 1940.

Also surviving are three sisters, Mrs. Albert Germann, Celina, O.; Mrs. Fredona Germann, Convoy, O.; Mrs. Michale Linn, route 1, Celina; eight grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren. Five brothers and three sisters preceded her in death.
