Fort Wayne Youth Dies Of Injuries

A third person involved in a two-car crash may 19, which claimed the lives of Jerry

Blair, 18, and his wife, Beverly, 17, of Decatur, died early Monday morning at the Lutheran hospital in Fort Wayne. John A. Stute, 20, of Fort Wayne, died at 3"30 a.m. Monday, as a result of injuries suffered in the Sunday evening May 19, crash on U. S. 27 in Allen county, one-half mile north of the Adams-Allen line.

Stute was a passenger in a car driven by Ronna R. Cordill, 20, of Warsaw, which was northbound and skidded across the center line, smashing head-on into the southbound Blair car and killing the Decatur couple instantly. The Warsaw woman was listed in fair condition at the Lutheran hospital Monday morning.

Services for Stute will be held at 3 p.m. Wednesday at the D. O. McComb & sons funeral home in Fort Wayne. (Tuesday, May 28, 1963)
