

Charles J. Ueber dies at hospital

Charles J. Ueber, 84, a resident of St. Anne's home, Fort Wayne, father of Rev. Charles J. Ueber, a former assistant pastor of St. Mary's Catholic church in Decatur, died at 2:10 p.m. Tuesday at Parkview memorial hospital, where he had been a patient three days.

He retired from the General Electric Co. 19 years ago after 41 years of service. He was a member of St. Peter's Catholic church, its Holy Name society, the GE quarter Century club, Knights of Columbus council 451, St. Vincent de Paul society, and Anthony Wayne Council, 4th Degree, Knights of Columbus.

Surviving are five daughters, three sons, a brother, three sisters, 24 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Friday at Mungovan & Sons South and at 11 a.m. in St. Peter's Catholic church. The mass will be con-celebrated by his son, Rev. Charles Ueber; his grandson, Rev.
