JOEL WINTEREGG DIES IN N. DAKOTA

Former Resident and Relative To Many Here Dies On June 2

(Handwritten date: Friday, June 11, 1943)

A report of the death of Joel Winteregg, 75, of Lisbon, North Dakota, was received here through a newspaper from that place. He died there on June 1, following a long illness. The deceased was at one time a resident of this community and was a twin brother to the late Dan Winteregg. He was unmarried and had no relatives where he was living, hence, no doubt the delay of his death message.

He was born in Wayne county, Ohio, on September 19, 1867, and left this community for North Dakota in 1907, where he lived a quiet life ever since. He was a son of David and Marianna Liechty-Winteregg, natives of Switzerland.

The following brothers and sisters preceded him: twin brother Daniel, John David, Mrs. Elizabeth Depp, Mrs. Judith Moser, and Mrs. Anna Locher. A host of relatives including many nephews and nieces reside in this community.

Funeral services were held at 8:30 o'clock on the evening of June 2. Death occurred in the home of Mrs. Haldis Holkestead, who cared for him during his last long illness.
