

## RETIRED FARMER EXPIRES AT 94

Bryan, O., May 6 -

Daniel B. Athy, 94, who at the age of 17 was rejected for Civil War service because of physical disability, died yesterday at his home six miles southeast of Bryan. He was born on the farm on which he died and spent his entire life there.

Surviving are one son, Mervin Athy, with whom he lived; one daughter, Mrs. Etta Brown of Toledo; four grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Viola Rath and Mrs. Sarah Jones of Hudson, Mich.

The body is at the Oberlin-Ford Funeral Home here and will be returned to the residence Tuesday noon. Funeral services will be held Wednesday at 2 pm at Union Chapel Church near his home, with Rev. C. A. Stewart of Bryan officiating. Burial will be in the Buck Cemetery.
