Our cemetery index book indicates that Elizabeth died on March 11th, 1868. However, I looked in both the 1865, and 1868 newspapers for that time frame and could not find an obit. But the newspapers were not good at all about printing deaths or obits in the paper. I could not find an Elizabeth Gill anywhere else in any of our books here.

I'm sorry we couldn't be of more help. If there were any children from this union I cannot find them. But our birth records here do not start until 1882. So they would not have been listed in there of course.
