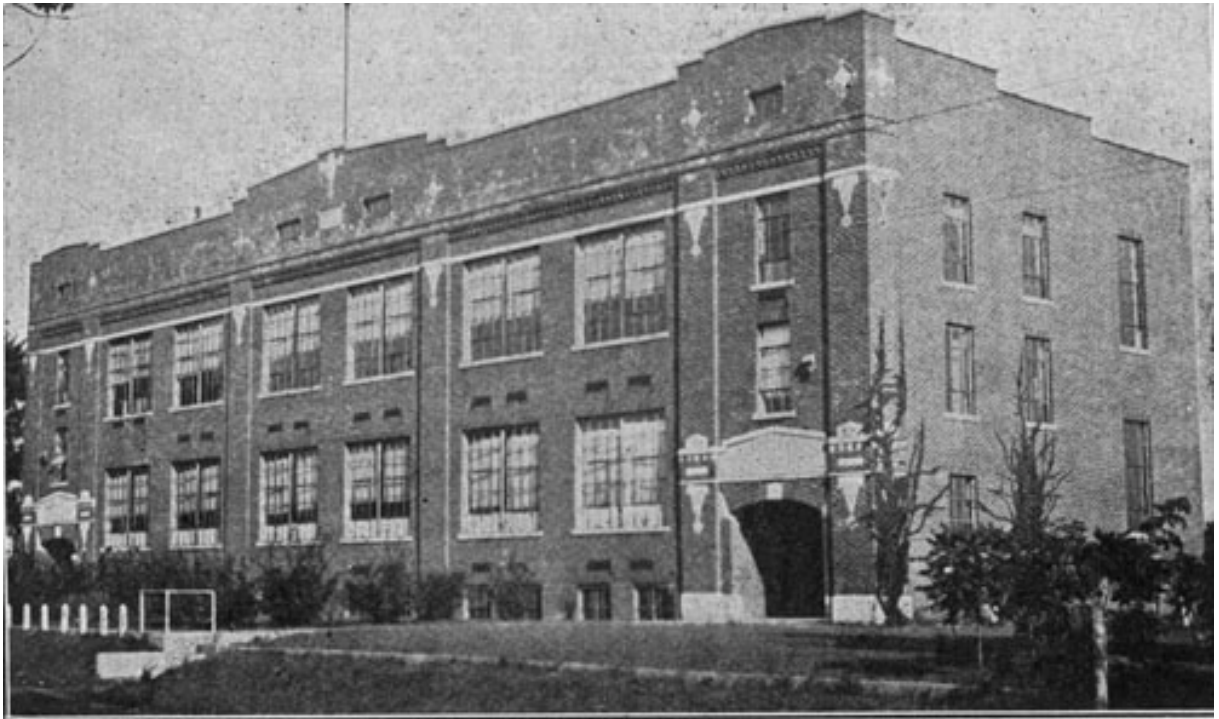


1929 Montezuma School Annual

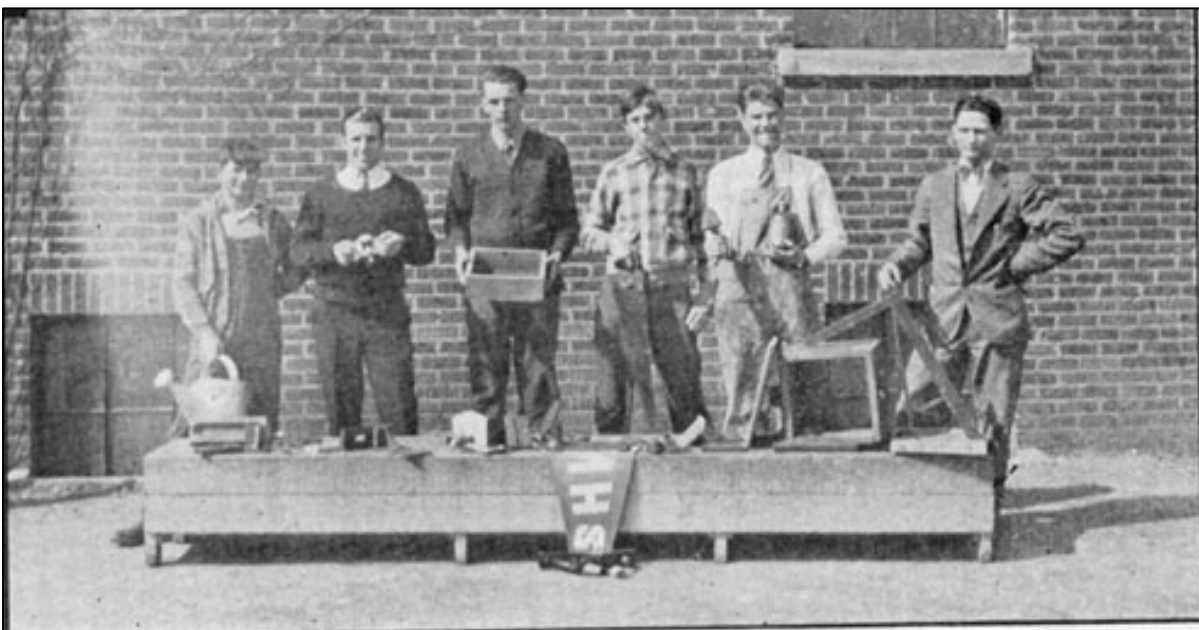

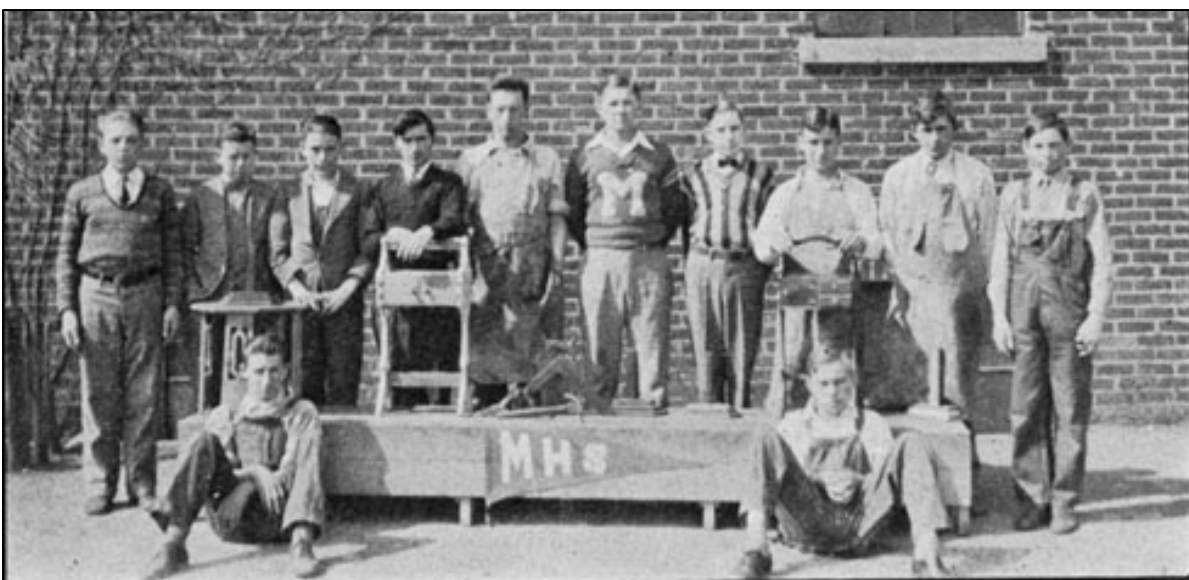

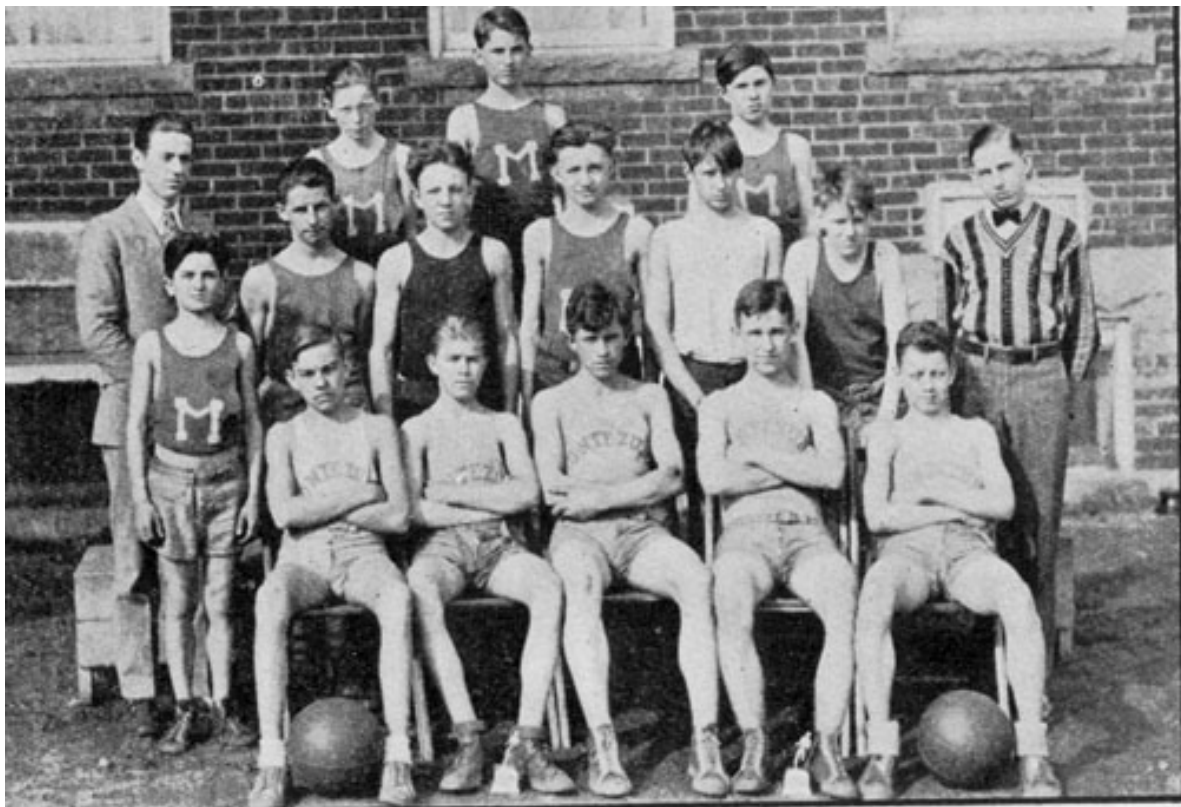

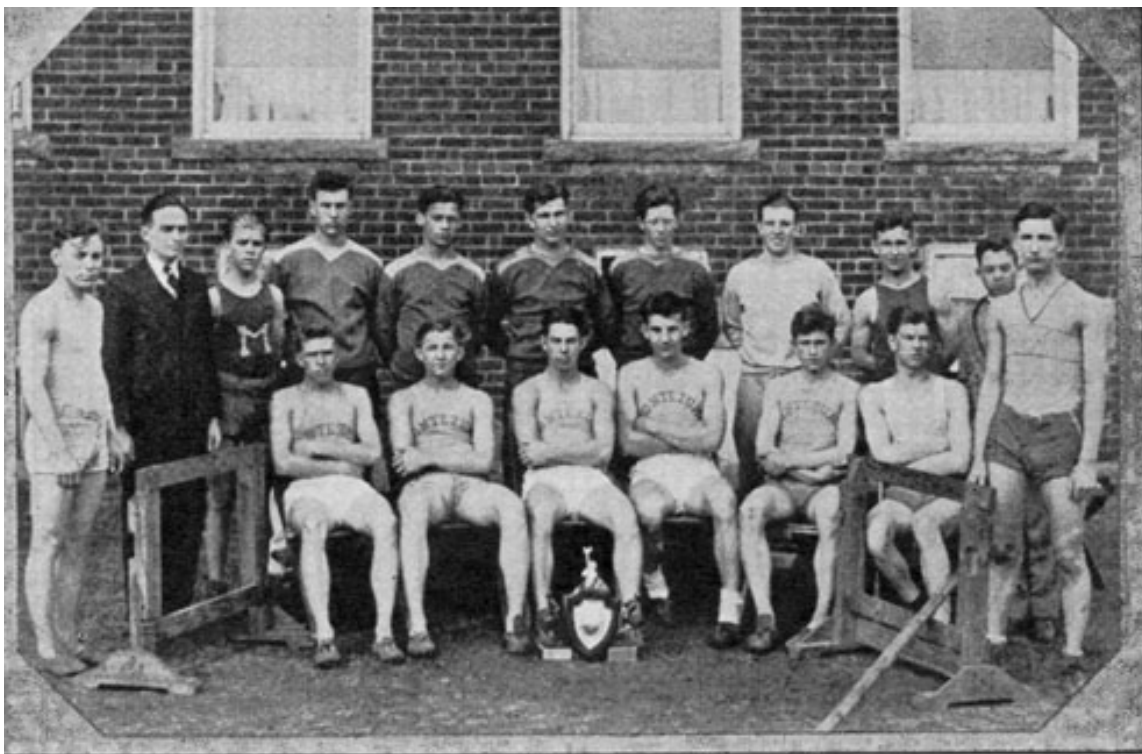
