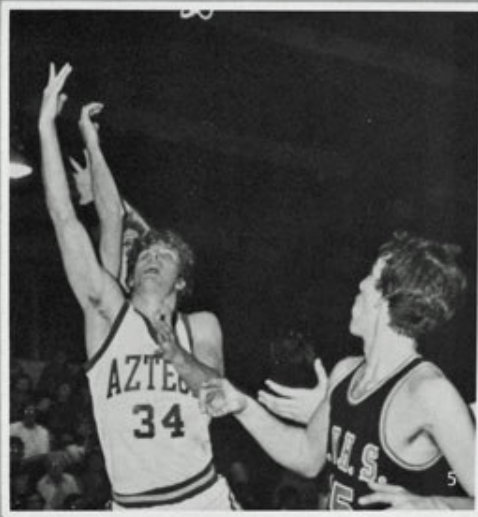

Boy's J.V. Basketball

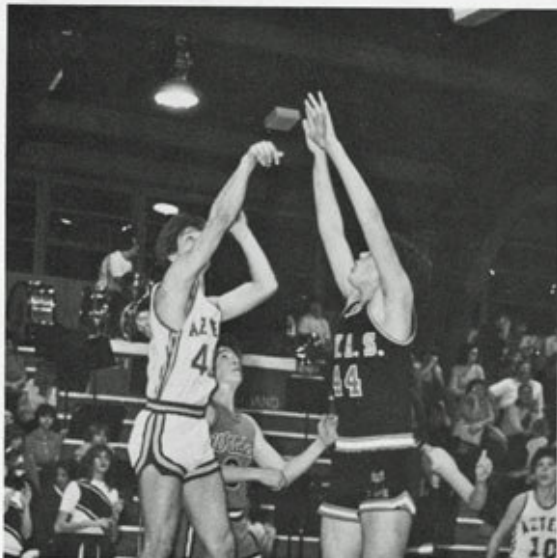
