Knopf conducted the funeral services, speaking from Luke 8-52, "Weep not, she is not dead, but sleepeth." The following brief obituary was read at the service:

Elizabeth Bassett was born near North Haven, Conn., April 22, 1815. When eight years of age she removed with her parents to Chenango county, N.Y. At eighteen she was united in marriage to Harvey Lewis, who survives her. In 1844 she removed with her family to Salem township, this county, where she resided the remainder of her life. She was the mother of seven children, four of whom survive her, three sons and one daughter. Deceased was 71 years and 9 months old. At the age of eighteen she united with the Presbyterian church, in whose faith she was always remained a firm believer.
