At her home in Metz, Sunday, May 12, 1895, Mrs. Eliza Palmer, aged 67 years and 10 days.

Deceased was born in St. Lawrence county, N.Y., April 22, 1828. She has lived in Metz many years – a widow living alone. It appears that she got up, built a fire and prepared her breakfast, then for some reason lay down upon her couch where she was found dead by her neighbor, Mrs. Sheline. Mrs. Palmer was a sister of Allen Jarvis, of Angola. Her son, Rhuel Sherman, of North Baltimore, Ohio, a sister, from Toledo, and other friends were here to attend the funeral, which was held at Powers church Wednesday, May 15, Elder Porter officiating.
