Robert Pew, aged 75 years, 7 months and 25 days, at his home in Scott township, March 13, 1888.

Mr. Pew was born in Monaghan county, Ireland, July 13, 1812, and came with his parents to America when twelve years of age, first settling in Trumbull county, Ohio. He was married to Almira Lovell, September 16, 1834. In 1854 he became a resident of Steuben county, which has ever since been his home. His first wife dying, he was married again to Miss Alice Tyler, who survives him. Six children also survive him, four of whom live in this county and two in Nebraska. Mr. Pew was a man who had seen much hard labor, and much anxiety and trouble, not caused by faults of his own. He has passed to that world where the things that trouble the living will molest him no more.
