This Sarah Anna is born in Parradies Township in York County, in the State of Pennsylvania in North-America and was baptised and got the Name Sarah Anna on the 20th Day in February in the year of our Lord, 1842 from Mr. Daniel Ziegler.

THE SPONSORS WERE:

through my baptism. Therefore I speak always happily,
