

Nila G. Schlagenhauf, 100, a resident of the Christian Care Retirement Community, died there at 7:20 a.m. Friday, June 4, 2010.

Mrs. Schlagenhauf was a housewife and was also a retail clerk at J.C. Penney before her retirement. She was a 1928 graduate of Petroleum High School and was a member of the Nottingham Church.
