

MARGARET CARNES PASSED AWAY AT 3
AGED LADY HAD BEEN SICK JUST ONE WEEK WITH PNEUMONIA.

Margaret Carnes, aged 73, widow of Robert Carnes, passed away this morning at her home in Liberty township at 3 o'clock after an illness of just one week. Last Saturday morning at 3 o'clock Mrs. Carnes awakened the family to tell them of her sickness which was diagnosed as pneumonia and this morning at the same hour, she passed away.

Mrs. Carnes was born in Guernsey county, Ohio, but in early life moved with her parents to this county, and all during her married life of fifty years she had lived in the same neighborhood for a few years just across the road of the present home in Chester township. She leaves on son, Robert, who lives at home; John Carnes, east of Bluffton; Ida wife of Will Beckler, of Uniondale; Minnie, wife of Lewis Medsker, of Oklahoma; Maggie, wife of Fred Baker, of Liberty Center. Two brothers, John and George Murray, also survive. Three children, all girls, preceded her in death. Her husband, Robert Carnes, has been dead about six years.

The funeral will be preached at the house, for and a half miles southwest of Liberty Center, Monday at 10 o'clock. Interment in Gruver cemetery.
