John Sayre died at 8 o'clock Saturday evening at the home of his sister, Mrs Isabella Holwerda , 216 Main street West Lafayette, His death was caused by Uremic poisoning. His health had been impaired for some time, but he was only confined to his bed for two days. Mr. Sayre was born and reared in White county and was 75 years old.. He served for nearly three years as a member of the ninety-ninth Indiana Infantry and after the war went to Helena Montana, where he engaged in Mining for forty years. He returned home four years ago and since that time had made his home with his sister. Levi Sayre of Battle Ground is a brother of the deceased. Mr Sayre never married .. He was a good man of rugged character, was a good citizen and was held in high esteem. The funeral will be conducted from the Holweda residence this afternoon at 1:30 o'clock. Rev P.O.Duncan will officiate and the interment will be made in Pierce Cemetery. (1912)

Battle Ground Indiana , Feb 26. Mrs Levi Sayers , one of the oldest and best known residents of this vicinity died at 7 o'clock Monday Morning at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs. O.S. Strantz at Reynolds. Death resulted from the infirmities of age and followed an illness extending over the past six weeks. The deceased was born at Chalmers Indiana May 21 1842 and was a daughter of Honathan and Sidney High, Pioneer settlers of White County, Practically her entire life was spent in that vicinity until about eleven years ago when the family moved to Battle Ground. Mrs Sayers was married twice her first marriage taking place in 1859 to Uriah Beasey. to this union seven children were born, on ly two of whom survive. In 1907 she was united in marriage to Levi Sayers who also survives. Mrs Sayers was a member of the Baptist church at Chalmers. Joining when the congregation was organized in 1897. She enjoyed a wide host of friends, her motherly traits endearing her to all who knew her. Besides her husband she is survived by one son, Edward Beasy, of Lafayette, and one Daughter Mrs. Florence Kellenberger of Monticello. Fourteen grandchildren and six great grandchildren also survive. The funeral will be held Thursday from the Baptist church at Chalmers. Rev Arthur Harmon officiating. Burial in the Chalmers cemetery.

Jimmy Sayre Former Boxer Dead at 61..

Manson Henry ( Jimmy) Sayre, 61 year old Lafayetter Former Boxer who three times fought for the bantamweight Crown. Died at 1:30 pm Saturday in Home Hospital where he had been a patient for about seven months. Mr Sayre a native of Badger Grove, spent his entire ring career as a professional. He fought his first fight in Frankfort in 1918 at the age of 14 after training in Lafayette. Before he retired in 1933 , according to Ring Magazine, he appeared in 308 fights and was never knocked out. The Magazine credited him with a 95 percent win record in his career, with 30 percent of his victories by knockouts. His pursit of the bantamweight title took him into three title bouts in Chicago - against Earl Mastro of Chicago in 1927 , against bud Taylor of Terre haute in 1928 and against Phil Goldstein of Philadelphia in 1929. Two other times he fought bantam weight champions but not for the title.

Olympic Aide He spent sometime in helping train American boxers for the Olympics and spent a year as a training assistant at Purdue University. He helped bring Golden Gloves boxing to Lafayette in 1930 and assisted in its promotion until World War II ended the series. Mr Sayre a resident of 319 S. 31 ST. was a toddler when the family moved to Lafayette. His father Ralph Sayre was also a professional athlete baseball .. He was an infielder for the Baltimore Orioles and Cincinnati Reds. After Mr Sayre retired from the ring in 1933, he operated a service station for some time. then worked for three local cleaners, finally going to Alcoa where he spent the last 14 years of his life ( until he became ill) as a sander-finisher. He married in 1925 to Bernice Juanita Shoup of Battle Ground. He was a member of the Moose Lodge and the Holy Trinity Lutheran Church. Surviving with the widow are four daughters, Mrs. Nola Gene Martin , Mrs Dorothy Nugent, Mrs Shirley Beck and Linda Buck and three sons Kenneth, JimmyF and Jerry Lee. All are residents of Lafayette except Jerry Lee who is with the Air Force at Rantoul ILL.. Also surviving are his mother Maude Hilt of the Soldiers Home, three sisters Mrs Martha Ruschili, City, Mrs William Mess of Anderson, and Mrs Clara Sekema of Ventura , Calif. two brothers Donald and Everett city, a half brother Robert Hilt , city and two half sisters Mrs Fred Deck and Mrs Joseph Bol, City.
